

## **CPAepi project**

Information on cultured *Aspergillus* strains isolated from patients with chronic pulmonary aspergillosis (CPA) is scarce. Information on the *Aspergillus* strain and resistance status is of crucial importance in the management of CPA patients, yet this information is not provided by the serological tests used to diagnose most published cases of CPA. Unfortunately some patients are unable to undergo bronchoalveolar lavage or transbronchial biopsy for mycological/histological analyses; thus, cultures for species identification and susceptibility tests are unavailable in many cases

### **Objectives**

To study the epidemiology and antifungal susceptibility profile of *Aspergillus* strains isolated from patients suffering CPA.

### **Inclusion criteria**

*Aspergillus* isolates coming from patients diagnosed with CPA following the ISHAM guidelines already published.

### **Material**

Cultures of *Aspergillus*
